Course Description and Goals:

This course is intended for Confined Space Entrants and Stand-by Attendants who may be required to:

1. Enter confined spaces
2. Work in confined spaces
3. Perform Stand-by attendant duties
4. Gas test confined spaces
5. Ventilate confined spaces
6. Perform non-entry retrieval rescues

A significant part of this course involves several hands-on exercises, including standby attendant duties, entry into confined spaces, gas testing, ventilation, lockout and retrieval rescue. Examples of permits and forms will be used.
